- **Differently Abled:** Applicable as per the provisions of the RPwD Act, 2016 to all the categories of disabilities identified. A student with 40% permanent disability of the mentioned categories and with a Unique Disability ID from the Government of India will be considered for the scholarship.
- **Defence and Paramilitary Quota:** Serving personnel; ex-servicemen; retired personnel and deceased personnel or their dependents from Indian Army, Indian Navy, Indian Air Force, Coast Guard, Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Border Security Force (BSF), Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Railway Protection Force (RPF), National Security Guards (NSG), Special Frontier Force (SFF), Assam Rifles, Border Road Organization / General Reserve Engineer Force (GREF), Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO), Military Engineers Service (MES) and Defense Security Corps (DSC).
- **Sports International Level:** A player who has represented India in any International Sports Competitions approved by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ SAI/ IOA/ FISU/ National Federation of Concerned Games approved by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ Association of Indian Universities/ School Games Federation of India. The student must obtain a certificate from the concerned authorities of the sport. The candidate should have participated and won in the International level sports/ games conducted by the competent authority.
- **Sports National Level:** A student who has represented for the state in any competition conducted between the last two consecutive calendar years at the national level in Individual/ Teams approved by the Ministry of Sports/ Sports Federation/ AIU. The student must obtain a certificate from the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ National Federation/ Board of concerned games only. The candidate should have participated and won in the National level sports/ games conducted by the competent authority.
- **Domicile:** The student should have studied and passed in one or more Government recognized educational institutions located in the State of Karnataka for a minimum period of SEVEN academic years commencing from 1st standard to 2nd PUC / 12th standard as on 1st July of the year in which the candidate is seeking admissions to and must have appeared and passed either SSLC / 10th standard or 2nd PUC / 12th standard examination from Karnataka State. In case of the candidate who has taken more than one year to pass a class or standard, the year of academic study is counted as one year only.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- This scholarship is applicable only to the Residents of Karnataka.
- The minimum academic eligibility for the respective programme at the time of admission should be 80% and above in both class 10th and 12th.
- EWS certificate to be submitted which is issued by District Magistrate (DM) /Additional District Magistrate (ADM) / Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/ First Class Stipendiary/ Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Executive Magistrate/ Taluka Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- Family income under the EWS category is up to Rs. 3 lakhs per annum from all sources.
- The tuition fee waiver plan is applicable for the entire tuition fee only.
- No disciplinary case was registered or reported.
- Applicant must be of Age 20 years or below.
- Possess a valid EWS certificate.

POLICY FOR ADMISSION UNDER CO-CURRICULAR AND CULTURAL SCHOLARSHIPS

▶▶ ABOUT

Our Cultural scholarships opens doors for next generation cultural prodigies who are passion driven and full of unique creative abilities. Through this scholarship, we have extended the requisite academic resources to such talented individuals. The scheme is designed to align students with the passion and ability to explore the scope of cultural fields ranging from dance, drama, and music to painting, sculpture and literature. This scholarship scheme is eligible for students who have proved their mettle in above referred activities and are desirous of joining Alliance University for pursuing their higher studies. The focus of this scheme is to promote cultural involvement and hone the innate skills of the students, while also providing an all-encompassing education to enable them to excel in the field of their choice. Students also need to reflect on a high code of conduct, significant social involvement, and active participation.

▶▶ Unique Features of the Scholarship Scheme

- In all the Undergraduate courses where the University determines the criteria of eligibility, Alliance University has reserved 02 (two) seats in each programme (created on supernumerary basis) to those candidates who have excelled in co-curricular activities in their schooling/ 10+ 2 programmes in State / National Level.
- Those students, who have represented their school/college up to their 12th standard in Cultural/ Literary Activities at the State/National/International Level Competitions and have won prizes (I, II or III only), may be admitted to the undergraduate programmes of their choice/eligibility up to a maximum of two seats in each programme (supernumerary seats to be created above the intake capacity) under the quota for excelling in co-curricular activities.

▶▶ The Candidates who Fulfil the Requisite Eligibility Criteria and Wish to Avail Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme, Apart from Academic Credentials, Need to Submit the Following to the University:

- Recommendation Letter and one minute WhatsApp videos by the mentoring institute or academy or private tutor or gurus.
- Documentary proofs showcasing awards, certificates won by students or participation of students in activities/events.
- Minimum 2 references of individuals who are associated with the applicant in the same co-curricular activity.
- Students can apply with relevant testimonials at : scholarship.au@alliance.edu.in | registrar@alliance.edu.in
- These scholarships shall be applicable for UG programmes offered by Alliance University.

▶▶ Perks

The University shall offer scholarships in the form of a tuition fee waiver to those students who participate and win awards (first prize, second prize, gold medal, silver medal etc...) at different levels as follows:

District Level	50% of the tuition fees in every year throughout their course of study at Alliance University.
At State / Zonal Level	75% of the tuition fees in every year throughout their course of study at Alliance University.
At National / International Level	100% of the Tuition fees in every year throughout their course of study at Alliance University.

▶▶ Attendance Waiver:

Up to 40% of attendance waiver from classes for scholarship recipients for participation in related events.

Mandatory 60% of attendance for academic engagement.

▶▶ Special Consideration:

For candidates shortlisted under this cultural/co-curricular scholarship and if they belong to SC/ST and PwD categories, there is an additional 10% waiver in tuition fees (if scholarship is less than 100%), along with free accommodation and food on campus throughout the duration of their programme at Alliance University.

▶ **Evaluation Process:**

- a. Holistic evaluation considering both quantitative achievements and qualitative contributions.
- b. Transparency and fairness ensured through a detailed scoring rubric.
- c. Continuous monitoring of scholarship recipients' performance and contributions

▶ **Terms and Conditions:**

- a. Scholarship renewal contingent upon sustained continuous excellence in co-curricular and cultural activities.
- b. Maintenance of satisfactory academic performance throughout the course period. The students should maintain their academic proficiency (minimum of 5.0 GPA in all the semester exams) and should not have any backlog in any of the semester exams. If students cannot reach the minimum standard of renewal scholarship policy, the scholarship would be withdrawn from that academic session onwards.
- c. In the event of any disciplinary action against the student during his/her stay at the University during the course of the study, they will not be entitled to avail any sports scholarship.
- d. Students must formally apply every year for the continuation of the scholarship on or before the last date as announced every year.
- e. It shall be the complete discretionary power of the VC/Registrar/Student Welfare Committee of AU to take decisions for recommending the awarding of scholarship to students.
- f. Any misrepresentation of achievements may lead to the revocation of the scholarship.
- g. The Alliance University Excellence in Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Scholarship is open to all undergraduate programmes offered by Alliance University. All eligible students pursuing UG programmes at Alliance University are encouraged to apply.

Students will receive complete support from Alliance University in accelerating their goals. Furthermore, the students shall be encouraged and groomed by the best mentors for the state and national level competitions in cultural and co-curricular activities.

» INTRODUCTION

Alliance University is embarking on a new journey to admit students to its much-coveted undergraduate programmes, in recognition of their excellence in sports. The programme is named "Sports Excellence Admission (SEA)". The objective of SEA is to reward and encourage students who have achieved a certain level of excellence in sports of their choice. Alliance University will be offering seats in each of its all undergraduate programmes through SEA by the creation of two supernumerary seats per branch for Indian Nationals (as per the decision (dated February 03, 2023) passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) 891 / 2021, OCI/PIO candidates who have secured OCI/PIO card before 04.03.2021 shall be considered as Indian national, for the purpose of admission to HEIs in India). The Sports Excellence Admission will be operational from the academic year 2024 – 2025. We at AU understand that Sports is not only an institutional activity, but it also helps in educating the youth. It educates the youth on behavioral qualities to help in their social and educational adjustment with society at large, irrespective of culture, religion, or beliefs. It is not only a method of recreational growth and development but also helps with the integration of young people into the country's social order.

» Aim:

To promote active participation in sports for nurturing talents in various sports disciplines and for the integration into the country's social order.

» Objective:

The policy envisages improvement in the standard of sports in the University by inviting and motivating the best talent in different sports by giving admissions through sports quota and offering fee waiver to outstanding sportsmen. It provide sports scholarships to medal winners and participants to promote mass participation in sports competitions being organized by the University.

It motivates sports people to achieve higher levels of performance by assisting them financially in relation to education and sports development.

The scheme would be applicable to those who secured the medal or participating in International, National University Games or State, National, and International Competitions Recognized by Olympic Association of India.

» Eligibility:

Represented India in Olympic Games, Asian Games, World University/ School Games, World Games, World Championships, World Cups, Commonwealth Games, Asian Meets, Test Matches in Cricket. Commonwealth Championships, Asian Championship. Asia Cup, SAF Games, Davis Games, Wimbledon Championship, US French, Australian Open Tennis Championship, Thomas Cup, Uber Cup, All England Badminton Tournament and International Athletic Permit Meet and any other International Tournament/ Championship, Games and Sports approved by IOA (Indian Olympic Association) and / Govt. of India/State Governments.

The candidate should either be a State Champion or should have participated in recognized National level / Inter-University level (AIU) / International Level sports competitions. The candidate should have cleared up the qualifying exam for admission to the programme applied for with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate. A relaxation of 5% marks can be given by the Competent Authority.

» Attendance Waiver:

Up to 35% of attendance waiver from classes for scholarship recipients for participation in related events.

» Games/Sports considered for Admission under SEA:

Number of Seats under Sports Quota:

Two seats per undergraduate programme created on supernumerary basis every year is allotted through the sports quota: one gender-neutral and the other female-only will be allowed under sports quota (on qualifying the entrance test). The Competent Authority will decide on allowing additional seats in exceptional circumstances. Unfilled seats of sports' quota till the due date of admission will be filled by general category students.

Applications for fee waivers under the sports quota will be processed by the committee constituted for this purpose.

Special Consideration:

For candidates shortlisted under this cultural/co-curricular scholarship and if they belong to SC/ST and PwD categories, there is an additional 10% waiver in tuition fees (if scholarship is less than 100%), along with free accommodation and food on campus throughout the duration of their programme at Alliance University.

10 GENERAL GUIDELINES

- An applicant is allowed to apply for the scholarship only under one category / discipline. Only a single scholarship can be availed by a student for the entire duration of the programme.
- Scholarships are subject to availability. Students will be awarded scholarships on a first-come-first-served basis within each category that they are eligible for.
- Students must continue the study at Alliance University the academic year for which the scholarship is offered. The scholarship cannot be deferred or transferred.
- Applicants must complete and submit the online application form available on our website. Ensure all required fields are filled out accurately and completely along with all the required documents. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- It is the responsibility of the student to submit all the original and supporting documents along with the scholarship form. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- All mentioned details provided by the student in the scholarship form must be accurate. If the information at any point in time is found to be incorrect / insufficient, the scholarship, if granted, will automatically be cancelled.
- Students must participate in the Alliance Selection Process (Admission Process) to be selected for any of the programmes. Post selection, the student must register for the programme to be eligible for applying for the Alliance Scholarships.
- Scholarship applications only determine students eligibility to apply for the scholarship. This in no way guarantees that the scholarship applied for will be awarded. Alliance Vidya Spandana scholarship committee will determine whether the scholarship can be awarded or not.
- Applications must be submitted by the specified deadline. Late submissions will not be considered..
- Scholarships are applicable to the first-installment tuition fees. Scholarship will be subject to the condition that the student consistently maintaining an academic record of minimum 6.5 points / GPA throughout the programme and subject to the decision made by the Alliance Scholarship Committee. There should not be any backlog in any of the semester during the entire programme of study. (Not applicable to Alliance Vidya Spandana scholarship)
- Students should not have any gap / break in academics during the programme.
- Students should not have indulged in any activity which attracts disciplinary action; if so the scholarship will be withdrawn.
- Performance only in qualifying entry level examination held in the two previous academic years before admission will be considered.
- Continuation of the sports scholarship in subsequent years is subject to satisfactory contribution to the sporting activities of the University. Scholarship applicants will be awarded based on their past academic excellence, financial need and extracurricular activities.
- The final list of scholarships granted for all programmes across categories would be announced post commencement of academic sessions. For the students who would be awarded one time scholarships, the amount would be adjusted against the last instalments, as per the fee payment schedule.
- The decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final, binding and not subject to appeal.

RENEWAL POLICY (for Second year Onwards)

The Sports Committee may propose the renewal policy pertaining to the scholarship for the students of the second year, as per the process listed below:

1. To continue to get the scholarship, the students should maintain their academic proficiency (minimum of 5.0 GPA in all the semester exams) and should not have any backlog in any of the semester exams.
2. If students cannot reach the minimum standard of renewal scholarship policy, the scholarship would be withdrawn from that academic session onwards.
3. In the event of any disciplinary action against the student during his/her stay at the University during the programme of the study or from any sports authority, they will not be entitled to avail any sports scholarship.
4. Students must formally apply every year for the continuation of the scholarship on or before the last date as announced every year, failing to decide in which scholarship would be withdrawn for that academic year.
5. It shall be the complete discretionary power of the VC/Registrar/Student Welfare Committee of Alliance University to take decisions for recommending the awarding of sports scholarship to students of the respective year of study for the student who has achieved position/participation in various inter-university / national/ international level sports competitions.

ATTENDANCE FOR SPORTS STUDENTS:

The attendance granted to students will be:

10% for inter school matches or other NCR competitions

35% for students who are participating in state, national, or inter-university (AIU) competitions

Criteria for students who are participating at the international level can vary on a case-to-case basis depending on the nature of sport. (Approval from the University competent authority will be required).

NOTE:

- Only those games /sports will be considered for the above-mentioned incentives /schemes, which the list of International Olympic Comm wee (IOC). Indian Olympic Association (IOA), Association of Indian Universities (AIU). School/ Nationals, MYAS (Ministry o/ Youth Affairs & Sports) and others.
- To continue to get the fee waiver the student should maintain a CGPA of 5.0 or above, failing which the fee-waiver for the subsequent years shall be withdrawn.
- The students should be required to participate actively at all university level Sports activities.
- The student's participation in various events will be subject to prior permission / approval.
- Performance of the previous three (3) years will be considered for of the scholarship.

11 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Sports Scholarship will be applicable to the District, State, National, International level position /participation, as per the details given above.
- The Scholarship will be applicable to the students throughout the total period of programme of study at Alliance University.
- A student cannot claim more than one scholarship in a single year.
- Students must submit all the required documents at the time of submission of the application for the Sports scholarship.
- The decision for the award of scholarship shall be taken by the duly constituted committee, and no claim will be entertained afterwards.
- The University has the right to change the terms and conditions of the Sports policy anytime without any prior notice.

In the event that there are candidates with the same number of points, the following tiebreaking criterion will be adopted.

- Candidates with higher points at international level will be allotted the seat.
- In case of a tie at the international level, points at the national level will be used for seat allotment.
- In the event of a tie at both international and national levels, seats will be offered to all the candidates with tie by creating additional supernumerary seats.

12 APPLICATION PROCESS

- Participate in the Alliance Selection Process (Admission Process) and get selected.
- Complete registration formalities for the chosen programme.
- Determine whether you meet the eligibility criteria for the scholarships and provide all necessary supporting documents.
- Download the scholarship application form from Alliance University's website and complete the necessary formalities.
- Scholarship application will only be considered when submitted to the Scholarship Committee, Alliance University, Chandapura - Anekal Main Road, Bengaluru – 562 106, Karnataka, India or emailed to scholarship.au@alliance.edu.in. No other correspondence address or email ID will be considered on or before the prescribed deadline.
- The scholarship committee shall evaluate each application and communicate the award after a personal interview of the applicants.
- Know the updated notifications from the University.

13 CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL

- Students must maintain a minimum 6.5 points / GPA and above each semester during the programme.
- No backlogs in any of the semesters during the entire programme of study at the University.
- Students must refrain from activities which result in disciplinary action.
- Application for renewal of scholarship must be done on or before 30th July of every academic year with a copy of all previous semester mark sheets.
- Students should not have a gap / break in academics during the programme of their study.
